a. Re-Opening Plan

b. Vaccinating testing and implementation policy

 Everyone must be double vaccinated and if the facility has one wall, everyone must be masked

c. Hartwood storage locker

- In April we were served with a notice that the fees were going up 10% which was \$10 and a new notification was just received that it's going up another 20%, so from \$100 to \$130 in three months
- Elphin and Aspasia will be going there Friday and will ask if there's something smaller and/or if the price can be guaranteed for a longer period of time
