One of my favourite things about spring is the return of the Hot Cross Bun. Needless to say, I was excited to discover this recipe in my Celtic Folklore cookbook. So here I present this scrumptious recipe.

HOT CROSS BUNS


makes 18 buns Celtic Folklore Cooking compiled by Joanne Asala first edition, second printing 1999

1 1/2 plus 2-3 cups flour
2 packages dry yeast
1 tsp cinnamon
3/4 cup milk
1/2 cup vegetable oil
1/3 cup sugar
1 tsp salt
3 eggs
2/3 cups currents
1 egg white, slightly beaten
1 1/2 cups powdered sugar
1/4 teaspoon vanilla
Dash salt



In a large mixing bowl, combine $1 \frac{1}{2}$ cups flour with the yeast and cinnamon. Heat milk, vegetable oil, sugar and salt in a saucepan until warm; stir constantly. Remove from heat and beat for 3 minutes at high speed with an electric mixer. Add all at once to the flour mixture along with the eggs. Beat at low seed with an electric mixer for 1 minute, scraping sides of bowl constantly. Beat 3 more minutes at high speed. Stir in currants and as much of remaining flour as possible. Turn dough out onto a lightly floured surface and knead in enough of the remaining flour to make a moderately soft dough that is smooth and elastic. Shape into a ball. Place in a lightly greased bowl, turning once to coat surface. Cover and place in a warm spot. Let rise until double, about $1 \frac{1}{2}$ hours. Punch dough down and turn out onto a lightly floured surface. Cover and let rest for 10 minutes. Divide dough into 18 pieces and form each into a smooth ball. Place on a greased baking sheet $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inches apart. Cover; let rise until nearly double (30 to 45 minutes). With a sharp knife, cut a cross in each; brush tops of each bun with some of the slightly beaten egg white (reserve remaining white), Bake at 375 degrees for 12 to 15 minutes or until golden. Cool slightly. Meanwhile, combine powdered sugar, vanilla, dash of salt and the reserved egg white. Add more milk if necessary to give it pip-ing consistency. Pipe crosses on top of buns with a pastry decorator.



With camping season almost here I have a great pattern to help keep you warm! Being comfortable has a great impact on how much fun an event is.

The best advice I can give you is to put on your warm clothes just before the sun goes down! This will make your whole evening more comfortable and fun.

Bog Coat is a great style from Norse to Russia and all points in between.

Here is a simple coat you can make from a surprising small amount of wool and even from a single blanket.

Look in second hand stores for wool blankets as a easy starting point. Some people have used polar fleece but it really does not hold the heat as well or stand up to rain. Wool blanket can also be dyed a different colour to suit your taste.

Added bonus: I open it up and lay it into my bed underneath me when I tuck in for the night to stay toasty warm.


